

Cycle Pannier 1 (Rear Cycle Pannier)

Yellow Bike Bag – Bag 1 (Panniers are labelled bag 1 and bag 2)

- All Cycle equipment is transported in Cycle Trailer.
- X6 bikes need to be secured with the straps. Ensure any bikes touching are protected with items like pipe insulation to prevent damage.
- X6 stocked panniers and x2 Empty spares
- X12 Cycle hivy vest
- Portable, rechargeable pressure washer
- Helmets
- Clinical grade sliders
- Front and rear lights, Horns/sirens
- Vests to be washed after each event
